For the period 10:53 on Sun 15/06 to 16:32 on Tue 17/06 the phone is cell sited in the DPA area (DPA).

At 21:43 on Tue 17/06 the phone hits cell EC1M 5LG (Farringdon Station area) - this is recorded as GPRS activity, there is no voice or text calls until the phone disconnects from the network.

Between 21:43 and 22:10 the phone travels through E1, E3, E13, E6 and into IG11, settling on aerial IG11 8LS (Harts Lane area) at 22:10

There is GPRS activity between 22:10 and 22:41 indicating internet browsing or internet enabled chat, eg instant messaging such as WhatsApp, Facebook Messenger etc

No usage seen between 22:41 and 00:00 on Wed 18/06 where there is a GPRS connection (in my experience, this is probably a case of the network refreshing the user's connection as it moved into the new date period, it could indicate an automated event and not the user doing anything physical to the telephone)

I have received the toxicology report and forwarded it to the Coroner:

**Conclusions**

1. GHB was detected in Mr Walgate's blood and urine at high concentrations which could provide a toxicological explanation for death.
2. The presence of citalopram, diphenhydramine and chlorphenamine were also detected at concentrations broadly consistent with the use of therapeutic amounts.
3. A low concentration of alcohol was detected in the blood and urine which may be the residue of alcohol consumed at an earlier time as described above.
4. With the exception of the solvent, 1-propanol, and quinine, caffeine and nicotine, none of the other substances listed under Nature of Examination were detected and Mr Walgate would not have used such substances in significant amounts in the hours leading up to his death with the possible exception of the alkyl nitrites ('poppers').
5. The presence of GBL, which is converted to GHB in the body, was detected in the liquid in the brown bottle, item DGP/17.

The organs have been reunited with the body by DC Parish and Dr Biedrzcki does not require any further samples for examination. Any outstanding actions are being reviewed and completed as appropriate and an updated report has been passed to A/DI McCarthy by me for submission to SC&O1 SIO for review and comment.

I requested DC Parish complete an MG3 and I have endorsed it for submission to the CPS. I would consider the charge of Perverting the Course of Justice appropriate considering the false statement made by PORT resulting in a far more protracted investigation than would have otherwise taken place. Further to this, the family have also been subjected to a period of uncertainty while the deceaseds movements were established which further aggravates the offence.
