PRIMARY INVESTIGATION DETAILS : 1 Immediate action

1. Cad number 1209 of the 19th June 2014. Pc Middlemiss 267KG, Pc Benson 186KG, Pc Reece 230KG, Pc Azam 280KG, Inspector Learmonth KG1N, PS Jones 83KG, Night duty KG5, SCD1.

2. On Thursday the 19th June 2014 officers attended outside 47 Cooke Street Barking after receiving a call from LAS to say that they were on scene with a male aged about 20 who was deceased in the street.

Officers attended and arrived a few minutes later and were met by the solo ambulance crew of K351 who was first on scene. The paramedic stated that they had received a call from mobile number 07973854105 from a male who didn't give his name and stated he was a passer by and had found the male collapsed in the street and thought he had a seizure, the paramedic stated that the control room had to call him back 4 times as the call kept cutting out. The paramedic stated that he arrived on scene at 0405hours.

The paramedic stated that when he got to the scene it was apparent that the male had been there a while and that his body temperature was 24 degrees.

The males body had been covered over by a red blanket on his top half and officers could only see his left knee sticking out from under the blanket. The male appeared to be leaning up against an small outbuilding at the communal entrance of flats 59-70 Cooke Street Barking.

Pc Middlemiss 267KG and Pc Benson 186KG were first on scene and after placing on gloves lifted up the blanket from the top of the subject to reveal the deceased male believed to be the subject.

The subject was leaning up against the outbuilding in a sitting position with his head leaning to his left
