<p><b>Additional support provided by MIT7 officers following inconclusive special post mortem on Anthony Walgate.</b></p> <p>Officers attended Fresh Wharf Patrol Base for a briefing with A/DI McCarthy. Following discussion with the IO, the following enquiries were undertaken by MIT7 officers:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Additional interview with arrested suspect Stephen Port. He has informed officers that the deceased was an escort that he had used and had moved him out of his flat following concerns for his wellbeing. He denies involvement in any criminal offences but admits to moving the deceased out of his flat. Full interview summary passed to DI McCarthy.</li> <li>Full forensic search and examination of 62 Cooke Street. DC Groombridge attended the scene with a local SOCO. The scene has been fully photographed and numerous exhibits seized. The flat comprises a living room / kitchenette, bedroom, bathroom and entrance hallway. There is a small exterior patio area to the front. Seized exhibits include swabs, bed sheet and duvet cover, substance believed poppers, laptop computer and clothing. In addition, a quantity of pornographic material has also been seized These items have been conveyed to and booked in at Barking.</li> <li>MIT officers located Port's vehicle (Peugeot RCZ registration: <span style="border: 1px dashed black; padding: 0 5px;">DPA</span>) near to the scene. This has been searched and photographed by SOCO.</li> <li>CCTV enquiries - Enquiries undertaken in the vicinity of the crime scene encompassing St. Ann's Road, Gascoigne Road and St. Paul's Road. There is a dummy camera in the top flat in block 64 - 87 St. Ann's. The occupier confirmed this was not recording and stated that she had already been approached by officers and spoken</li> </ol>
