I am the above named person and I make this statement on request of Detective Constable GRAFTON of the Metropolitan Police in regards to two persons stopped at Barking Railway Station back on Wednesday the 4th of June 2014.

Due to the time now past, my recollection of the incident is very slim, so I make this statement referring from my Pocket Note Book 38585 pages 006-008 and Local British Transport Police intelligence report Reference number BDRR00008884.

On Wednesday the 04th of June 2014 at 2133 hours I was on duty in uniform at Barking Railway Station where I was in company with Police Constables ANDREWS 2640 , GALEA 2782 , Police Community Support Officers BONNAR 6880 and FEARNE 4265 .

Barking Railway Station is made up of eight platforms. At the London end of the platforms has an under pass which inter joining them. The country end of the platforms has a staircase which leads up to the concourse. On the concourse there are a number of automatic ticket barriers which is the only entrance and exit to the station. On the exit side of the ticket barriers are a number of shops which are located inside the station.

At this time we had received a report from a member of rail staff stating that a male had assaulted another male and was going down his bag. They believe this person was trying to steal his phone.
