On 14/9/15 this young man was discovered deceased by the groundskeeper. He was positioned sitting up against the outer perimeter wall. His head was slumped forward with mucus coming from the nostrils. About his person was a clean syringe, an empty packet of white powder in his wallet and a small bottle of clear liquid (unlabelled). His hands were by his side. Red marks across his chest laterally? in keeping with the body position being slumped forward. CID attended and deemed non suspicious. Body and scene photographed. White powder and clear liquid secured by police. For H&C authority to proceed to post mortem and decision on whether the liquid and powder should be sent for analysis along with routine tox.
