PRIMARY INVESTIGATION DETAILS : 1 Immediate action

****This cris has been requested by DS Sweetman as for all actions to be logged re the sudden death****

On Monday 14th September 2015 762kg Taylor and 820kg Holder were on cycle patrol in Abbey ruins, Barking when we were flagged down by a refuge cleaner (viw 2) who informed them that he was concerned about the well being of a male in the park, he said "there is a male round the corner slumped up against the wall who doesn't look good" we rode straight round to the area which was only about 50 yards away from where we flagged down.

It was 1310 hours when we rode over to the apparent Lifeless male who I now know to be (Viw1)Mr Jack TAYLOR Dob 20/06/1990. The male was sitting up against a stone wall in the south western corner of the green; he was slumped forward with his back up against the wall. He was an Icl male with short brown hair wearing a black jacket, blue shirt, Navy jeans and brown slip on shoes. His eyes were closed and he had a large amount of nose mucus coming from his right nostril. His skin colour was Ashen, he was cold to the touch and his body and joints were completely stiff as if rigor mortis had set in. I could smell faeces coming from the Lifeless body. It was also apparent that the Lifeless body was very wet due to the heavy rain showers that had recently occurred. There were no signs of life, chest movements or breath. It was very apparent the male had deceased. Pc Holder was with me as we examined the body for any visible injuries or suspicious circumstances. I could not see any visible injuries on the lifeless body apart from reddening crease

I conducted a crime assesemnt at the scene in relation to anything which indicated that this incident was suspicious. There were no obvious signs of anything that would lead me to be

believe that the victim had been subjected to 3rd party interference.

No signs of struggle

Property still on his person in his pocket

No obvious wounds from an attack.

No marks consistent with strangulation to the neck

Body found in clear view of the Public, no attempts to hide/conceal.

All of the above indicated to me that this incident albeit tragic at such a young age was not suspicious.

My suspicions are an overdose or a severe reaction to some form of medication mixed with controlled drugs. I make this assessment based on the syringe, white powder and clear liquid found on him at the time and the subsequent knowledge that he was on medication from hospital for headaches,

This is a non suspicious investigation and unless anything is discovered subsequently to change this then the investigation will remain with Team under the guidance of Insp O'Donohue and Sgt Tanner.

My team and I are available to assist with any queries/guidance.

called Steve who gave us further information from which we were able to establish that a phone call to them was made by the jacks mobile phone at 0238 hrs (13/09/2015) requesting a taxi to take him to Barking Train Station. The name given was 'James' we believe this to be Jack. They are aware of Jack as he often uses the firm.

a Taxi from Alphabet taxis picked up Jack at 0243 from his home address. The taxi in question is a Silver Ford galaxy VRM [DPA] the drivers name is Shamsaddin AHMED driver no 181 T [DPA] [DPA] The controllers log states that the male was dropped off at barking Station at 0248.

The home address of the driver [DPA] Dagenham was visited by 762Kg & 820KG. He was not in but his son was spoken too. At this time we have made no further contact with Mr Ahmed.

Due to the further information that we received at Alphabet taxis we attended LBBB CCTV offices in Clock House Avenue to see if we could trace Jack = and the Taxi.

On viewing CCTV 762KG & 820KG (review no 693) at 0248the same time that we were given by the controller we saw a vehicle matching the description match the description of the Silver Galaxy pull into station parade on the opposite side of the road of KFC near to the entrance of the car park for Vicarage Fields. The footage was not clear enough to see what the VRM was. We do believe from what we have seen that a Male matching Jacks description was seen to alight from the taxi and cross the road and stand outside KFC close to a phone box for a couple of minutes. It is not clear if he makes any contact with any passers by at this time. Shortly after

a male walks from the direction of the town centre and meets with the male who we believe to be Jack. Both males then walk towards the town centre together before they are seen to turn left into Clock House Avenue.

CCTV last shows them both together outside the Barking learning Centre. The male who was with Jack appears to be a larger built male IC1 with a bald head. At the time of the CCTV being reviewed it was not possible to get a facial recognition he sat that it is jack although officers believe it too be him.

I have just contacted Donna Taylor by phone and have updated on our enquiries today. She confirmed that the taxi company do refer to Jack as "james". I have informed her that she will be contacted later today by Ps Laffan

From the cctv that we have been able to obtain so far we have images of Jack being dropped off at Station Parade opposite KFC at around 0248 hrs on Sunday 13/09/2015. He is the only person to be seen alighting that vehicle which appears to be the silver Ford Galaxy taxi from Alphabet cars. As the taxi drives off, Jack is seen to cross the road and loiter around on the pavement outside KFC near to a phone box. It is unknown if Jack goes into the phone box.

Jack is seen to wander along this area and goes out of shot for around 1 minute as he nears the junction of Cambridge road. He is seen to wander back into shot and continues to wait outside of KFC.

At around 0300 hrs an unknown male walks up Station Parade from East Street and meets Jack outside KFC. They both immediately walk together back along Station Parade towards East Street. This part has been captured by LBB&D cctv cameras.

Images follow the pair as they walk along Station Parade as they pass The Barking Arms Public House, The DayNight Pharmacy and Lloyds Bank. These three premises have there their own cctv and each show the two men in slightly clearer detail.

LBB&D cameras show the two men turn left from East Street into Clockhouse Avenue passing the back gates of the old Barking Police station. They then cross to the paved square at the front of the town

hall and the Barking Library. So far this is the last visual we have of the two males together. Close to this area is the new Barking Leisure Centre. There is no trace of the males on their cameras.

Enquiries have also been made at the Child and Family Centre Axe Street. Apparently they have just discovered a fault on their CCTV system and it appears that no images have been recorded for the past month.

Also in this area is a high rise block of flats called Waterman Court. There are two cameras on the outside of the building they may be of use. There is no on site concierge service for this block. From a cleaner I have obtained a contact of John Monigan [DPA] I've tried this number numerous times with no reply.
