Hi Jayne,

The special PM yesterday was inconclusive, awaiting toxology. Dr Swift did say there was bruising under the arms, as well as pinpoint bruising around the eyes and some bruising on the neck. The viocebox however was intact.

He thought that the bruising was consistent with strangulation (could not make a call on strangulation), but could also have been caused by fitting after overdosing.

Toxology will be looking for traces of GHB. There was also no evidence of sexual assault.

I have e-mailed Mark Yexley asking him to send you a copy of the ID statement ASAP.
