

active investigative role. Indeed, in many ways one is reliant upon the information which is provided to you by detectives or officers investigating a particular scenario for the purposes of then trying to disseminate it to the family members in a sensitive and appropriate manner, so that they neither feel that any information is being kept from them, but equally nothing is done which could hinder or prejudice any investigation. Being a FLO was not my only task and during the relevant period between June 2014 over the next twelve months I would say that my average work load in terms of other cases I was dealing with was in the region of 15 to 25 cases at any given time, there was also prisoners in custody to deal with, trial preparation and attending court, monitoring the radio channel and assisting response team on a daily basis. Resources on the Borough were very limited at times in relation to detectives and investigators. There were three teams working different shifts which meant we hardly saw each other during our professional working lives and certainly there was not a great amount of social "mixing" that took place either within each team or between the teams in my experience. I found that you were usually too busy trying to manage your own case load and the roles and responsibilities which you had undertaken or had been designated to you to pay too much attention to what others were doing. There was a tendency to try and just keep on top of your own case load and manage that and wherever possible try to assist others, where this was achievable.

3. I have been provided by the IPCC with what is referred to as "bespoke disclosure" and advised that it is proposed only to interview me on the basis of that material alone. I am grateful for the indication that at the conclusion of my interview it will be permissible for me to be allowed the opportunity to consult with my Federation Representative, and legal advisors, further to provide a further written response in relation to any specific matters in relation to which I feel I can offer further assistance or clarification.

I have viewed the CRIS Report that has been made available in relation to Anthony Walgate (5109868/14) and can see that I was appointed the FLO for the family on the 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2014 when I made an entry at 23.01 I was on a late shift. Most of the contact I had was with Anthony's mother Sarah Sak and his father
