There was no obvious sign of a struggle, and the body was in full view of the public.

DS SWEETMAN asked the officers to carry out a full search of the body, removing clothing to establish if there were any wounds or obvious marks that would raise concern. The officers confirmed to DS SWEETMAN, that there was nothing that they could see indicating a wound or attack.

I asked PC MERRITT to check the wall behind where the body was found, in case other property or mobile phone was discarded behind the wall. The search came back negative.

At 1445hrs, DS SWEETMAN deemed the death as non suspicious, based on the fact that there was no an obvious mark or wounds on the body. Shortly after, I left the scene.
