Okay, erm we're at an interview room at the IPCC in Croydon. Er, my name's Ben WILLIAMS, I'm the lead investigator for the IPCC investigation, erm which has the erm, investigation name Operation Wasabi, but essentially it relates to erm, the Metropolitan Police response to four deaths in the Barking area, erm between 2014 and 2015, which have now, erm resulted in the conviction of murder of Stephen, conviction for murder of Stephen PORT. Erm, it's DS SWEETMAN'S interview today. Erm, I'm just going to go round the table, I'll just ask everyone to introduce themselves for the purposes of the tape and int, introductory purposes as much as anything else. I've also got my colleague with me.
	LB	Yeah, I'm Lizzie BURCH, I'm an investigator here at the IPCC and I've been assisting Ben with this investigation.
	BW	Okay. Yeah.
	PS	DETECTIVE SERGEANT PETE SWEETMAN.
	BW	Yeah. Okay.
	SW	Er, my names Simon WARWICK, I'm a Detective Superintendent, and I'm here as Pete's friend I think it is.
	BW	Yeah. Erm, police friend, well to...

I NEEDED TO KNOW AT THAT POINT BEFORE WE START SAYING ACTUALLY I'M QUITE HAPPY IF THERE'S, IF THERE'S, IF THERE'S NOTHING STICKING OUT AT THIS POOR GUY THEN IT'S NOT SUSPICIOUS. I KNOW THAT THAT'S NOT THE CASE. I, I'M EXPERIENCED ENOUGH ERM, I'VE BEEN DOING THIS JOB A LONG TIME AND AS FAR AS I'M CONCERNED I'M A BLOOD GOOD DETECTIVE. ERM, I'M NOT GONNA LISTEN; I'M VERY MUCH GONNA LISTEN TO AN ACCOUNT GIVEN TO ME BY SOMEBODY ELSE BUT I'M NOT GONNA TAKE THAT AS BEING READ THAT THAT IS ACCURATE. MY JOB THERE IS TO GO, OKAY THANKS FOR THE ACCOUNT, I'M NOW GONNA TEST THAT ACCOUNT AND I'M GONNA SEE IF WHAT YOU'RE SAYING ACTUALLY ADDS UP, OR I'M GONNA SAY, DO YOU KNOW WHAT, YOU'RE ABSOLUTELY RIGHT BUT I'VE FOUND AN ISSUE HERE. SO THAT'S, THAT'S WHAT I WAS DOING AT THAT POINT, WAS CHECKING THROUGH THE ACCOUNT THAT I WAS GIVEN.
	BW	So you're checking what they've done but then you're trying to move it on as well by...
	PS	YEAH, ABSOLUTELY, YEAH.
	BW	You said, yeah check that, what you've done, but then we need to move beyond that to the next stage and, yeah.
	PS	ABSOLUTELY, YEAH.
	BW	Yeah.
	PS	BECAUSE THEY HAVEN'T DONE THAT AND THAT'S MY JOB TO...

WELL I'VE AGAIN DISCUSSED THIS WITH THOSE THAT WERE PRESENT, SOME OF WHOM MAY WELL HAVE BEEN MORE EXPERIENCED THAN I IN THAT AREA, BUT I WAS EXPLAINING, I REMEMBER EXPLAINING THAT I DIDN'T SEE A NECESSITY AT THAT TIME DUE TO, I, I WAS STRUGGLING, IN FACT I COULD NOT SEE ANY SUSPICIOUS CIRCUMSTANCES OTHER THAN THE FACT THAT OBVIOUSLY GABRIEL WAS THERE AND HE HAD DIED, ERM THERE WAS NOTHING INDICATING TO ME THAT THIS IS HOW HE HAD DIED, AND THERE WAS NOTHING INDICATING TO ME THAT CLEARLY SOMEBODY ELSE WAS INVOLVED. YES IT WAS UNEXPLAINED,</p>

ERM, I WAS TOLD PRETTY MUCH AT THE OUTSET THAT THIS IS AN AREA KNOWN FOR ERM, STREET DRINKERS, ROUGH SLEEPERS, DRUG TAKERS, ERM AND THAT'S THE KIND OF THING THAT WAS GOING ON THERE ON A VERY REGULAR BASIS. ERM, AGAIN I'D NO EXPERIENCE OF THE AREA, ER BUT IT WAS IMPORTANT TO ME TO KNOW IF THAT'S EXACTLY WHAT IT WAS, BECAUSE THAT HELPED ME AGAIN WITH MY DECISION MAKING PROCESS. ERM, IF THAT HADN'T OF BEEN THE CASE WOULD IT HAVE CHANGED ANYTHING, NOT NECESSARILY TO BE HONEST, BUT IT WAS CERTAINLY AN IMPORTANT FACTOR FOR ME BECAUSE TO KNOW THAT THIS IS AN AREA THAT PEOPLE COME TO TAKE DRUGS, WHICH IN THE BACK OF MY MIND WAS WHAT I WAS THINKING, BECAUSE I COULDN'T SEE A CONCLUD, I COULDN'T MAKE A, AN ASSESSMENT AT THE TIME EXACTLY WHAT HAD CAUSED GABRIEL'S DEATH, ERM, HOWEVER, YOU KNOW BEING HONEST HE WAS A SKINNY, ER HIS BODY WAS VERY SKINNY, ERM AND I'M NOT SAYING THAT I COULD TELL IMMEDIATELY HE WAS ON DRUGS, BUT I'M A POLICE OFFICER AND IF I LOOKED AT SOMEONE I THINK I'D LIKE TO BE ABLE TO ASSESS THE SITUATION WHERE I MIGHT THINK ACTUALLY IT'S POSSIBLE THAT THIS GUY WAS TAKING DRUGS, AND THAT'S THE KIND OF PERSON THAT HE LOOKED LIKE. 	BW	And, and what was your experience around attending deaths as a, as a DC or in, in previous roles of BTP and?
	PS	NOT HUGE. ER MY, THE MAJORITY OF MY EXPERIENCE IS IN COVERT POLICING.
	BW	Yeah.
	PS	EVEN IN THE BTP I WENT STRAIGHT TOWARDS PROACTIVE POLICING AS OPPOSED TO REACTIVE. I SPENT A SHORT PERIOD OF TIME IN UNIFORM BEFORE MOVING ON TO CRIME SQUADS, ERM THEN PROGRESSED ON TO LIKE A NATIONAL CRIME SQUAD SCENARIO FOR THE BTP ERM, DEALING WITH SURVEILLANCE AND COVERT DEPLOYMENTS.
