Summary

The victim Daniel Whitlock was found  
deceased in St Margarets Church graveyard  
North Street, Barkley.  
He was holding a note indicating he had  
accidentally addressed a male partner  
while they were having sex and had  
taken his own life because of this.  
The male mentioned on the note had  
been found deceased in the same graveyard  
on 28/8/14. This was deemed as non-  
suspect at the time.  
The body of the second male has been  
reinterred to Slough, although it looked  
two samples was taken.

- See suspects to be taken to possibly identify  
last sexual partner.
- Take toxicology samples
- Take heart hair for long term drug use
