## The Out of Hours Scheme Applies

Monday to Friday	5pm to 7am*	
Saturday and Bank Holidays	4pm to 7am	
Sunday, Christmas Day and Good Friday	Midnight to midnight	
these applications may be heard at Lavender Hill	de to a magistrates' court. On Saturdays or Bank Holidays I, Thames, Highbury, Barkingside, Willesden, Westminster, I Green and Bromley.	

Between the hours of 5pm and 7pm it may not be possible to guarantee to return a call in the time periods set for the normal scheme.

## Guidance Notes

- Where a call cannot be answered immediately, police officers will be invited to leave a message and any call will be returned within 60 minutes
- The out-of-hours service should be used only where the need to execute a warrant is sufficiently
  urgent that it cannot wait until the next business day
- Police officers must only use the contact numbers provided above and should never approach a
  magistrate directly
- Police officers should expect magistrates to allow only one officer into their home to make the application
- Police officers will be required to produce their warrant card before being allowed into a magistrates' home
- The magistrate will retain the information and any relevant schedules or copies and return them to the court.
